### Monday December 6, 2010

- 6:30 AM Target, Rt 283, Harrisburg
- 7:00 AM Weis Markets, Simpson Ferry Rd., Mechanicsburg

- 1:00 PM Arrive Williamsburg – meet guide at The Woodlands
- 1:30 PM Guided Orientation Tour - Enjoy a guided tour of the Colonial Williamsburg Historic District. This tour will give you insight into the area so you can better plan your free time and what you would like to see and do.
- 4:30 PM Hotel check in – The Woodlands, set near a pine grove adjacent to Colonial Williamsburg’s Visitor Center. You can walk or shuttle to the Historic Area. Hotel Guest Pass included, good for the length of your stay. This Pass gives you access to all public buildings in the Historic Area, as well as the museums (Abby Aldrich Rockefeller, DeWitt Wallace, and Bassett Hall).
- Abby Aldrich Rockefeller Folk Art Museum***—Discover the oldest institution in the United States dedicated solely to the collection and preservation of American folk art. It’s an extraordinary celebration of art that captures everyday life by making novel and effective use of the materials at hand.
- DeWitt Wallace Decorative Arts Museum***—Explore the Foundation’s renowned collections of more than 60,000 British and American decorative arts dating from 1600 through 1830. Learn the stories behind these rare treasure and the lives they touched.
- Bassett Hall***—Located on 585 acres of gardens and rolling woodlands, this 18th-century frame house was home to John D. Rockefeller Jr. and his wife Abby Aldrich Rockefeller during the Historic Area restoration. Today the house and gardens look much the same as they did when the Rockefellers lived there in the 1930s and 1940s.
- 7:00 PM Dinner included at Kings Arms Tavern  
King’s Arms Tavern —After Jane Vobe opened the King’s Arms Tavern in 1772, it became one of the town’s most genteel establishments. Present-day diners can savor traditional southern fare, sumptuous desserts, and after-dinner cordials.
